
KIDNEY FILTERING EXPERIMENT







I. Gather supplies



2. Add soil, beads, salt and glitter.

4. Create a filter.




5. Test out your filter.




6. Experiment with other filters.




7. Keep testing.



8. Filter out as much as possible.





Principal cell - A cell of the collecting duct responsible for absorbing water.

Intercalated cell - A cell of the collecting duct responsible for absorbing acids and bases.

Glomeruli - A cluster of capillaries around the end of a kidney tubule where waste products are filtered.

Filtrate - Fluid that is filtered from the blood. Much of the filtrate is reabsorbed into the body.

Tubules - Part of the nephron leading away from the glomerulus. These tubules twist and turn until eventually empty into the collecting duct.
