A check-up is an opportunity to protect your child from illnesses, check their growth, spot any developmental issues, and check in on their mental health. Don't wait until they're sick! Well child visits are essential preventive medical care. Here is some information to help you navigate your child's check-ups and get them ready for their visit



Help Your Kid Cope

Many kids feel nervous or scared about going to the doctor. Here are some tips to help them feel more comfortable:

- **W**
 - Learn what will happen.

Read a picture book about going to the doctor.

Use a toy doctor's kit to do a practice run.



Help your child feel calm.

Encourage them to bring a stuffed animal.



Be honest.

Don't make promises you cannot keep. ("You are not getting a shot this time.")



Offer something to look forward to.

"After the appointment, let's go to the playground."

Well Child Visit & Immunization Road Map

Regular well child visits help healthcare providers to support your child's physical, emotional, and social development. While most immunizations follow the standard schedule, your child's healthcare provider may occasionally recommend vaccines outside of the roadmap based on individual health needs or risk factors. In addition to routine childhood vaccines, children may also need seasonal immunizations such as influenza (flu), COVID-19, and RSV. These vaccines help protect against illnesses that circulate during specific times of the year and may be recommended even if they are not part of the routine schedule.




Find the Missing Tool
